We had a great night last Wednesday at the cluster meeting held at the Manningham Club to hear the updates about the North- East Link project. The meeting was hosted by Templestowe Rotary Club with Luke Bastian greeting everyone and Brian Negus chairing.

We heard from Duncan Elliott Chief Executive Officer of North- East Link who gave an interesting power point presentation with great photos to show what the end result will be. He said one of the most difficult aspects to date has been dealing with the businesses along Bulleen Road which have to be compulsorily acquired to enable works to proceed – during lockdowns when many were not functioning or not at full capacity.



He said one of the most positive and interesting aspects of the project was solving the problem of how to landscape around the large ventilation structures. It will be covered with earth and landscaped to form a huge public space with native vegetation and bike paths etc. It did look impressive in the photos.
