Guest Speaker: Greg Rowell – manager of the Warrandyte Riverside Market took us though an update of the market and logistics.

Greg said, based on current predictions of a hot summer, that at least one market is likely to be cancelled this summer due to projected bush fire/heat risk. Here are some of Greg's slides.





Fast Facts

- · Your involvement in the market commenced in May 2016.
- · We have just passed the 7-year mark.
- · You have organised 89 markets since you started this journey.
- The 100th market will occur in June 2024.
- · Your operating licences allows for 172 sites.
- + up to 15-20 additional sites on the private church lawn under arrangement.
- · It's the largest community market in the eastern suburbs both in the number of sites and attendance.
- · Between 4,000 and 6,000 people visit the market on each market.
- · We have a professional medical unit on site each market.
- We employ a toilet cleaner to maintain a professional level of cleanliness.
- ..and importantly we have a very good relationship with the Manningham Council.

...so where are we today for 2023:

- The market this year will gross \$158,400.
- It pays around \$3,500 in operating expenses per market.
- It puts back into the community through partner payments, sponsorships and grants over \$116,000.
- It is the largest community fundraising activity in the region.
- It supports many local businesses both directly and indirectly.
- ...and importantly has 4 major bus routes that stop at the market doorstep.



...so where are we today for 2023:

- We now communicate with all stall holders using Burst SMS text messaging.
- We have an online ordering system which requires all stall holders to pay three months in advance.
- We have a committed team of volunteers and contractors.
- We regularly get applauded as being one of the friendliest markets around.
- We have an online application process which currently has 3,054 applications on the data base.
- · We use social media extremely successfully.

...and as of today, the future for 2023:

- Our online ordering system has \$152,130 of sales committed for this year.
- · Which represents 2,062 sites.
- Which represents 96% of our available inventory for the year.



...and now for 2024:


- We will have to lock in a new three-year licence deal.
- We will need to do this by middle of December 2023.
- This will enable us to put sites on sale for the 2024 market season at the beginning of January.
- We will need to look at our site fees to see if any increases are required. Currently a standard site is \$70; a site with a car space is \$80 and a premium site on the bitumen is \$90, with table sites at \$45.
- Currently our operating costs represent approx. 27% of our gross revenue, so our profit margin is a healthy one!


