**Community:** Rob Edwards reported that the Hunter Valley Bus Disaster Fund will close on 11<sup>th</sup> September so there will be one more disbursal of funds to all the relevant people covered by the fund. Total raised was around \$1, 258,000 which is a staggering amount. The orphaned children are being cared for



by other funds. Rob said the management of the fund set up by RAWCS (Rotary Australia World Community Service) has been exemplary and it has been mindful to stick stricktly to the Terms of Reference for the fund so that money has gone only to those listed on the ToR's.

Louise Latimer reported that the **Meals on Wheels** as we know it will close down very soon due to the local councils relinquishing this service which will be taken up by individual care providers. So the Christmas Cakes for MOW recipients will not go ahead this year. It was suggested that the club buy the cakes and distribute them some other way to needy people in the community. This will be considered by the committee.

#### **Guest Speaker: District Governor Ian Ballantine.**

lan has been a Rotarian for 26-27 years in the Rotary club of Bentleigh Moorabbin which is a breakfast club. Ian is an accountant, but many of us know him as the District Photographer as he has always been at the front of any district event taking the official photos. Ian said photography is a great interest of his, along with sailing and motor bike riding. Ian's partner is Helen Parker, an emergency doctor at Sandringham Hospital. Helen's Partner Project is End Polio Now.

lan's father was a Rotarian and he talked a little about how Rotary has changed since it's heyday when it was very prestigious to be a member of Rotary and how membership was restricted to only one person of a particular classification. He said joining Rotary is a big commitment and sadly that is one reason people are not joining like they used to.

lan talked briefly about the upcoming merger of District 9810 and D 9820. He recently attended the MUNA (Model United Nations Assembly) event for senior secondary school students held in Berwick and he said it was very successful although the students did not dress up quite as well as in past years when it was held at Parliament House.

lan mentioned The Rotary Foundation which is the essence of Rotary and how important it is to Rotary – in that it means every club and member can be involved in creating difference in the world. He thanked our club for its ongoing generous support of TRF.

He mentioned International President Gordon McInally's theme of Creating Hope in the World and urged us to look at his speech when he talked about this year's logo. He urged us to support projects around Mental Health which has become the number one issue for Youth today.



lan indicated that our club was in good hands and he finished his address by urging us to take note of the 10 points to enhance the Rotary experience – clear expectations of new members, good engagement of members, foster partnerships, value the service experience, friendly processes, have information about Rotary, address issues, hold surveys and forums and engage in fellowship.

In closing President Don announced that our club would donate \$2500 to DG lan's partner Helen's project End Polio Now. DG lan was very happy and subsequently we heard that Helen also was thrilled with that news.
