The Rotary Warrandyte Art Show has grown over the 3 decades to where up to 550 works are exhibited .

From a small event it has graduated through many stages of growth in a range of venues including schools, halls and Mechanics Institute. For many years it was staged in a large marquee on the banks of the Yarra.

For the past few years the art show has found a home in the Community Church Warrandyte which provides a large air-conditioned and secure venue.

The art show is run over 2 days and one night in conjunction with the Warrandyte Festival which is conducted on the banks of the Yarra adjoining the Community Church. This sees the town swell with locals and thousands of visitors capturing Warrandyte's unique village atmosphere and enjoying its arts and crafts heritage.

The opening night is a Gala affair which provides guests with an opportunity over food and refreshments to meet many of the artists and have the first bite of the rich pickings on sale. This event is largely supported by around 200 guests and will feature an auction of select works, and opportunity



to be a lucky winner of an artwork raffle.

Proceeds from the art show are used by The Rotary Club of Warrandyte Donvale in community service projects in the region.
