
## **Personal Giving to End PoliO**

## **Significant Decrease in Polio Cases**

I'm pleased to report a significant decline in the number of Polio cases so far this year. In the 55 days from 1 January

to 24 February the total number of wild polio virus cases in the world is just 2-1 in Pakistan and 1 in Afghanistan. If the rate of infection remains at this rate for the whole of the year (a big if, I know), then the total number of cases could be as low as 14 for 2021. Compared to the 2019 number of 176 and the 2020 number of 140. Could we really have the end in sight?
